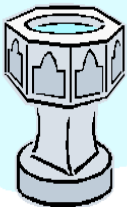
If you are able to Gift Aid your donation please fill out the label on the front and HHP will be able to claim that on your giving.

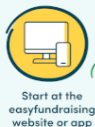

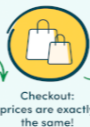
