Out by sharing God's love through service, action and mission—each group will be encouraged to have a specific 'Out' focus/project

SOME INITIAL PRINCIPLES

GROUP SIZE: up to 6 (for the moment due to Covid 19 restrictions) but ideally 8 to 12 – this leaves room for future growth!

SIMPLICITY: in a nutshell, groups should be all about love and challenge – thus they will not always be comfortable places, but they will be safe places

EXPECTATIONS: We want to have high expectations of our groups, believing they really can make a difference.

FREQUENCY/SCHEDULINGOF MEETINGS: most likely fortnightly, and different groups will meet at a range of times and days;

WHEN WILL THE GROUPS BE LAUNCHED?

We aim to begin our new groups in early 2021 (COVID 19 allowing).
