The newly renovated Scargill House, set in 90 acres of wonderful Wharfedale near the village of Kettlewell (about an hour's drive from Bilton) is again the setting for our next parish weekend in November 2024, following wonderful weekends there in 2019 and 2022.

One of the great advantages of going to Scargill is that we will be joining with an existing faith community who make it their aim to serve guests and make their stay a really positive experience.

Our adult programme will be led by the Scargill team, and members of the community will also lead the separate children's work and activities. There will be a good balance of input, free time and opportunities to get to know each other better, and our aim is that we come away from our time together refreshed, encouraged and having grown in fellowship.

NB 1 Scargill have a bursary scheme to assist with costs in case of hardship, and help with paying for children and young people is also available via a local charitable trust. The PCC may also be able to help. Hopefully this makes it clear that personal financial circumstances should not be a barrier to any individuals, couples or families wishing to attend. Please email/speak confidentially to one of the clergy for details if you would like to come but cannot afford to pay the full cost.

NB 2 The PCC is also inviting contributions from people who feel they might wish to support the weekend, whether or not they are able to attend, not least because the above prices are being subsidised to make the weekend as affordable as possible.

Payment can be made by cash/cheque/card or via BACS. Details upon request.

What rooms are available?

There are 35 bedrooms. Currently there are:

- 13 = standard single
- 5 = standard double
- 6 = standard twin
- 1 = standard triple
- 4 = en-suite double (2 have adjoining bunk rooms for children)
- 4 = en-suite twin
- 2 = twin easy access en-suite

When do I need to book by?

We need to let Scargill know our numbers by Monday 20th May Rooms are allocated on a first come first served basis and en-suite and double rooms do get booked up quickly.

How can people pay?
