Kidz Klub Christmas Hamper Appeal 2025

This year is the 22nd year that our churches have collected for Kidz Klub, which does some fantastic work with families from inner-city Leeds. Last year, our unprecedented 74 hampers amounted to about one in every three that they gave out, and this is all thanks to your generosity and kind hearts and a generous grant from Foresters Financial thanks to Val. There will be boxes at the back of both churches for any donations and the last possible date to drop them off is **Sunday 30th November.**

Include as many of the following as possible: Christmas biscuits or chocolate logs, non-alcoholic mince pies, Christmas pudding, Christmas cake or stollen, savoury snacks (breadsticks, crackers, nuts, crisps), chocolates or sweets, pamper items such as bubble bath for adults, soft drinks, new craft materials, paper and card, stickers, colouring and activity books, crayons and pens, pencil sharpeners, small toys, jigsaws, books and games., Christmas crackers or other Christmas decorations.

Please do not include any of the following: Basic food items (rice, pasta), meat products, alcohol or products containing alcohol [it is surprising how many Christmas goodies do], out of date food or food that will be out-of-date before Jan 2026, homemade foods, cakes or sweets. Please do message me if you have any questions or if you require a collection. Donations of money are absolutely fine and they enable us to even up the hamper contents. Bless you all. Everyone currently using envelopes will receive a letter soon with more information. If you'd like, you can alternatively switch to the **Parish Giving Scheme** or set up a **regular gift directly through your bank**.
